Meaning of reset:

- To set again; to reset an alarm clock; to reset a broken bone; to set, adjust, or fix in a new or different way; to reset priorities; to reset prices.

Why is it important to reset our internal lives?

- Global reset: Noah and the flood
- Spiritual Reset: Abraham and Isaac
- National Reset: The returned from Babylon

Let us look at some biblical perspective on resetting!

Text: Deuteronomy 6:4-9 (The Greatest Commandment)

“Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your Eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.”

Text: Matthew 22:37-40

Jesus said to him, “ ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Youshall love your neighbour as yourself.’ On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.”

The Great Reset Initiative is an economic recovery plan drawn up by the World Economic Forum (WEF) in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The project was launched in June 2020, with a video featuring the then Prince of Wales Charles released to mark its launch.

The initiative's stated aim is to facilitate rebuilding from the global COVID-19 crisis in a way that prioritises sustainable development.

5 reasons for personal reset:

1. Overcoming Challenges:
