### Some definitions of the word

- Meeting or coming across. Encounters can refer to a meeting or coming across someone or something unexpectedly. It implies a brief or casual interaction with another person or an unexpected event or situation.
- 2. Also a face to face interaction: encounter can also describe a face to face interaction or engagement with someone or something. It often implies a direct and personal experience or confrontation.
- 3. Encounter can be used to describe an experience or event that is significant or memorable. It suggests an impactful or meaningful occurrence that leaves an impression or has an effect on someone. Almost like a marking or branding. Marked by God. So overall encounter refers to a meeting, interaction, or experience. Whether it is planned or unexpected.

  - a. Romans 10:14-17
  - b. Acts 4:13
- 5. Encountering God strengthens and affirms the power in you to no longer struggle with sin.

  - b. 1 John 3:6-7
- 6. Encountering God ushers in a greater desire to build the kingdom.
